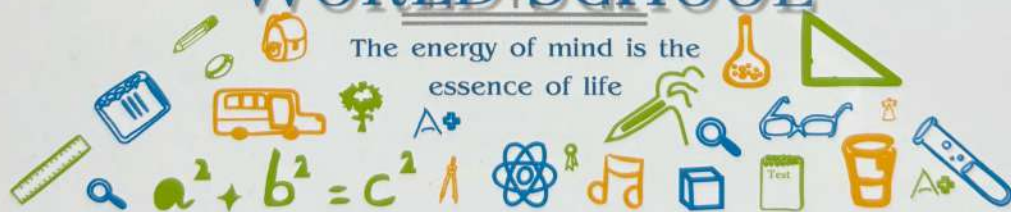

The counselling Department at ARISTOTLE WORLD SCHOOL serves as a support for students. ARISTOTLE WORLD SCHOOL teachers are expected to have many qualities to create rapport with their students. The counselors are facilitators of these teacher-student relationship, and move into action when developmental dysfunctions, stresses, or family problems exceed the capabilities of the teacher-student paradigm. In this capacity, we counsel students individually, meet with families, and confer with the student's extended support system as needed to overcome obstacles and get the students back in their maturational stream.

ARISTOTLE WORLD SCHOOL counselors serve as consultants who work with individual teachers, parents, advisors, and administrators to help them understand how to effectively address the learning differences of our students, and appreciate the dynamics of multiple intelligences. This would include uncovering and affirming students' strengths, and overcoming resistance to remediation by turning students into self-advocating collaborators in the educational experience.

We create weekly support groups specifically designed to help students with special needs. Examples are : Groups involving self-esteem issues, assertiveness, conflict resolution, peer pressure, drug and alcohol awareness, and diversity. We make referrals for students with special needs and arrange staffings. We facilitate strategy meetings with teachers, parents, educational specialists, and advisors to enhance students' success. Counselors attend weekly divisional staff meetings to stay connect with the needs of students and evaluate how interventions are progressing.

- We need to identify less assertive students and encourage involvement in leadership activities.

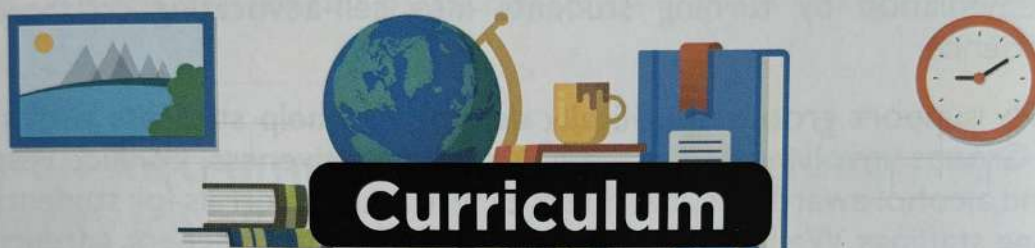

Curriculum

As pioneers in educational innovation, we have implemented the NEP's Learner-Centric and experiential learning approach to provide our students with a holistic education. Our curriculum is designed to foster collaborative learning, personalized learning, and hands-on experiences, giving our students the opportunities to explore and excel in their areas of interest. With a foundation in Foundational Literacy and Numeracy, we aim to nurture well-rounded individuals who are equipped with the necessary skills and knowledge to thrive in an ever-evolving world. Overview of NEP:

The New Education Policy (NEP) proposes a broad overview of a multi-disciplinary, learner-centric, flexible, and innovative education system. NEP aims to make learning fun, interactive and meaningful with the incorporation of the latest pedagogical practices.

Pedagogical Structure:

According to New Education Policy Aristotle World School, Etawah also introduces several pedagogical practices including Collaborative Learning, Personalized Learning, and Experiential Learning.

Collaborative learning will focus on group work, collaboration, and communication among students, allowing them to learn from one another.

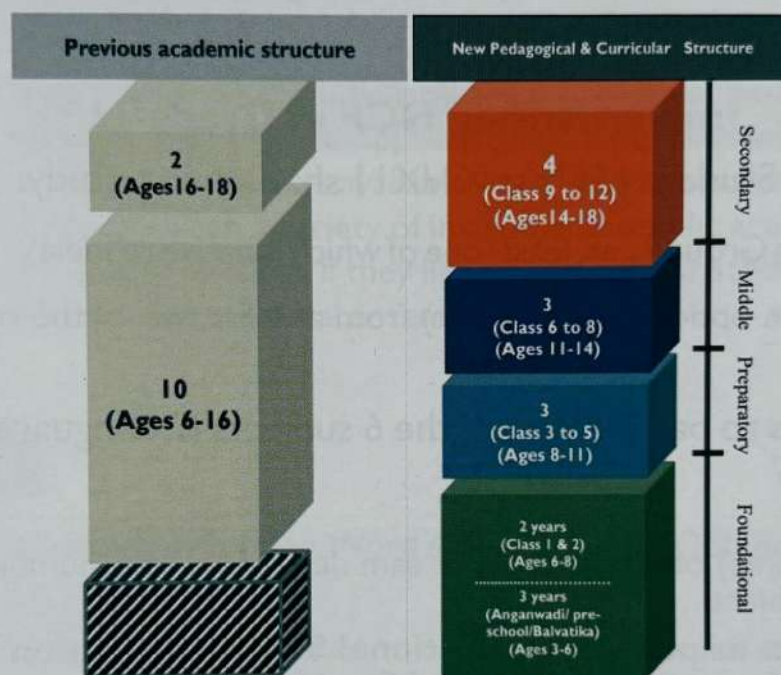
Personalized learning will focus on individual learning needs, learning styles, and learning outcomes for each student.

Curriculum Structure:

The NEP proposes a 5+3+3+4 structure, replacing the existing 10+2 structure. This means:

- The first five years will focus on Foundational Literacy and Numeracy, and Play-based, Hands-on Learning Activities.
- The next three years will lead to the holistic development of the student.
- The next three years will allow for the choice of subjects as per individual needs and interests.
- The final four years will lead to the achievement of learning outcomes, employability, and personal and professional growth.



Curriculum of Aristotle World School, Etawah

- **Foundational Literacy and Numeracy:** In the initial years, emphasis will be given on building strong Reading, Writing, and Mathematical Skills progressively. An age-appropriate curriculum with interactive games, hands-on experiences, and innovative teaching methods will be designed and implemented.
- **Holistic Development:** In the middle years, focus will be on the rich and diverse subjects that include Environmental Studies, Arts, Culture, Sports, and other Immersive Extracurricular Activities for students allowing for deeper engagement and personality development.
- **Choice of Subjects:** In the third level of education, students will have the flexibility to choose from a range of subjects as per their interests and future aspirations. Career Counselling will be provided to identify and explore emerging areas of study.
- **Achieving Outcomes:** The final level of education would focus on learning outcomes leading to employability, Personal and Professional Growth. Students will learn about emerging trends and technologies to equip themselves for the future.

Academic Program for Secondary & Senior Secondary

STREAMS

Implementing NCF in Grade 9

- As per NCF-SE, a Student of Class IX/X shall have to study:
 - 3 Languages (R1, R2, R3) at least two of which are native to India.
 - 7 subjects - Mathematics and Computational Thinking, Social Science, Science, Art Education, Physical Education and Well-being, Vocational Education, and Interdisciplinary Areas
- A student has to pass in all 10 subjects (3 Languages + 7 subjects) to be declared 'PASS'

Implementing NCF in Grade 11

- As per NCF-SE, a Student of Class XI/XII shall have to study:
 - 2 Languages (From Group I, at least one of which is native to India).
 - 4 subjects (with an optional fifth subject) from at least two of the remaining groups i.e., Group 2, 3 & 4)
- Thus a student has to pass in each of the 6 subjects (2 Languages + 4 subjects) to be declared 'PASS'

The subject combination(s) offered in each stream depends on the number of students in a batch opting for the subject.

Various Skill Subjects as per NSQF (National Skill Qualification Framework) are provided in relation to the interest of Student

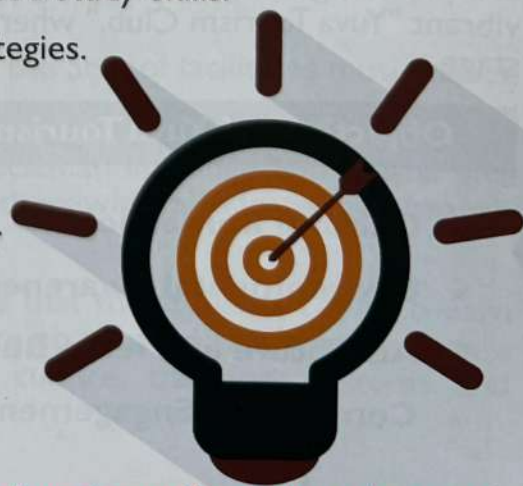

GENERAL RULES OF THE SCHOOL

- Aristotle World School reserves all rights of admission and refusal of the students as per the will of the admission committee without assigning any reason.
- If the parents do not want their ward to continue for the next session, they must inform in writing, giving three months notice, failing which they will have to pay dues for May and June and security money will not be refunded in this case.
- If a student leaves school in mid-session even after two or three days, the parents will have to pay all dues for 12 months of ongoing session.
- A student may be expelled from the school due to irregular attendance, misbehavior, disobedience, dishonesty or using unfair means in examination.
- Fee once paid will not be refunded in any case. Fee-structure is subject to revision.
- Parents are requested to communicate any change of address without delay.
- Parents are requested to make all reports direct to the Principal.
- 10% fee concession is given to wards of Serving and Retired Defence Personnel, 10% fee concession is given to wards of Defence Widows.
- 100% fee concession is given to a student belonging to a poor family on the basis of outstanding performance.
- In case of any legal occupancy, all matters should be subject to Jurisdiction Etawah only.



GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION

A How to obtain application form

- 1 The Application Form and Prospectus can be obtained directly from School Office during office hours 8 am to 3 pm in any working day.

B Submission of Application Form

- 1 Application on prescribed Form complete in all respects for all classes be submitted either in person or by post before the due date. All applications will be submitted in the office of Aristotle World School. Application Form will be accepted between 09:00 am to 03:00 pm on all working days.
- 2 The application fee is non-refundable and no correspondence on this subject will be entertained.
- 3 Application Form must be filled in and duly signed by the applicant's guardian.
- 4 Incomplete Application Form(s) shall be summarily rejected.

C Entrance test/Admission Procedure

- 1 Admission to all classes would be done through a Written Test and Interview basis. The syllabus of written test will be given at the time of Registration.
- 2 All candidates are required to appear at the Entrance Test and Interview in accordance with the admission schedule. In case of change in the admission schedule, if any, a notice will be put up on the School Notice Board as well as informed personally by phone or mail.
- 3 Only those candidates who possess a valid Admit Card for Entrance Test shall be permitted to sit in the Entrance Test.
- 4 The list of the candidates selected for interview shall be put up on the Notice Board of the School.
- 5 Selected candidates are required to bring their Admit Cards issued for Entrance Test and attested true copies along with the original of the following documents at the time of the interview:
 - ◆ Proof of Passing the Qualifying Examination.
 - ◆ Proof of Valid Age Certificate (Birth Certificate).
 - ◆ Character Certificate from the school last attended.
 - ◆ Transfer Certificate from the previous school.
 - ◆ Certificate from an M.B.B.S. doctor or govt. hospital certifying blood group (after final selection of the candidate)

Late Payments

Please be regular and punctual in paying fee of the school. Fine will be imposed for late payments as per the school norms. Further, if the fee is not paid even after a month of the stipulated date, the student will be de-listed from the class and barred from attending classes. Failing to clear his/her dues will not be allowed to sit for the final examinations

Attendance

- 1 Students shall be regular in their classes and must have 85% attendance.
- 2 A student must pay his/her fees and obtain his/her admission slip. This must be presented to concerned class teacher in order to get the name included in the Attendance Register within 15 days of admission.
- 3 Attendance of the students shall be counted from the date of admission in the respective classes.
- 4 If a student is found to be continuously absent from the class without prior information for a period of 4 days or more his/her name shall be stuck off the rolls and he/she may be readmitted again only after the payment of Re-admission fee.
- 5 The Statement of attendance will be displayed on the Notice Board of the class room from time to time. Students are required to keep themselves acquainted with regard to the position of their attendance.
- 6 A relaxation to the maximum extent of 15% of the total attendance shall be accorded to the student on account of sickness, participation in school functions, School Sports and prescribed Educational Tours/Field Trips/Field Work on such terms and conditions as prescribed in the relevant ordinance. The request for any such relaxation must be sent to the Principal/Class Teacher.

Students Discipline

Discipline includes the observance of good conduct and orderly behavior by the students of the School. The following and such other rules as framed by the School from time to time shall be strictly observed by the students of Aristotle World School.

- 1 Every student of 'Aristotle World School' shall maintain discipline and consider it his/her duty to behave decently at all places.
- 2 No student shall visit places or areas declared by the Principal as Out of Bounds for the students.
- 3 Every student shall always carry his/her Identity Card issued by the Principal. Every student, who has been issued the Identity Card shall have to produce or surrender it as and when required by the School Staff.
- 4 The loss of Identity Card, whenever it occurs, shall immediately be reported in writing to the Principal/Class Teacher.

Breach of Discipline, inter alia, shall Include:

- 1 Mobile Phone, other electronic items, wearing jewelry or costly items are not allowed inside the School Campus.
- 2 Causing disturbance to class, office, Library, Auditorium, Play ground etc.
- 3 Disobeying the instructions of teacher or the authorities.
- 4 Misconduct or misbehavior of any nature at the time of Examination.
- 5 Misconduct or misbehavior of any nature towards a teacher or any employee of the School or any visitor to the School.
- 6 Giving publicity to misleading accounts or rumours amongst the students.
- 7 Not carrying the identity Card issued by the Principal without any valid reason.
- 8 Any other conduct anywhere, which is considered to be unbecoming of a student. Students found guilty of breach of discipline shall be liable to such punishment, as FINE, CAMPUS BAN, EXPULSION, OR RUSTICATION.
